For generations Mount Dora has been renowned for its lovely, sheltering tree canopy. It's one of the reasons residents and visitors alike see Mount Dora as "someplace special". In recent times we've lost many of our oak trees to old age, disease and storm damage. Many more are in decayed condition and will need to come down.

Here's the good news: MOUNT DORA FRIENDS OF THE ENVIRONMENT is gearing up for the 2023 fall planting season with a goal of planting 100 more trees. We have helped update an earlier tree survey by the city and are determining where the best placement for new trees will be. BUT ...

WE need your participation, too. With your generous donation, Mount Dora can continue to have the restorative, sheltering canopy for which it is known. Anyone can donate a tree to the City of Mount Dora, a designated "Tree City USA". Donations over \$ 99 will have a leaf, acorn, or other item inscribed and placed on the tree mural in the City Hall lobby, be thanked on our website and receive a tax-deductible receipt from the Mount Dora Community Trust.

Our 2023 Capital Campaign Goal is \$40,000. All funds will go toward tree purchases and tree plantings thru a designated grant to the City of Mount Dora with specific criteria to be administered by the City's new Arborist and a 7-member Citizen Urban Forest Advisory board. These Board Members do not have to be members of the MDFE, but must live in the City's municipal boundaries or utility service areas.
